- 1. Please refer to Pre and Post Operative Instruction Sheet in addition to these instructions.
- 2. You may have dressings when you go home. It is important that you do not remove or get them wet for 2 days. You are to look at surgical sites at least twice per day.
- 3. Two days after surgery, you may remove all dressings and shower.
- 4. You may gently cleanse the nipple area with a mild soap and water. Rinse and pat dry. Avoid any pressure or irritation to the nipple.
- 5. You may apply small amount of antibiotic ointment to area twice a day for one week.
- 6. The sutures will be removed or absorbed in 2-3 weeks. Please notify our office of any sutures that have not yet dissolved after this time or if you notice any redness or drainage.
- 7. Notify the office of fever >101.5 degrees, significant redness, or if the nipple turns blue, purple or black. Please be aware that the nipple size will decrease over the next several months and this is normal.
- 8. If you choose to have nipple/areolar tattoo, you may schedule in approximately eight weeks. Please contact our office.
